Resolution naming roads in Campbell County, TN all-terrain friendly

**WHEREAS**, Campbell County, TN desires to promote tourism and recreational activities for its citizens and visitors within the county because of the community benefit it provides and the positive economic impact it has on the community; and

**WHEREAS**, Campbell County, TN desires to have its own laws governing the use of all-terrain vehicles in order to provide a safe, suitable and appropriate venue for the enjoyment of such activities within Campbell County in designated areas and the enforcement thereof and laws that meet or exceed State and Federal laws and which will be compatible with any laws for a trail system at such time as local trails are established; and

**WHEREAS**, Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, any all-terrain vehicles may be operated on the following portions of highways/roads within the jurisdiction of Campbell County, Tennessee.

See attached list of county roads and approved sections of state highways.

**WHEREAS**, for the purpose of this resolution, all-terrain vehicles are ATV, UTV, dirt bikes and similar type vehicles determined to be suitable and appropriate for safe operation on the streets of Campbell County, TN and all-terrain vehicles being further defined by Tennessee Code Annotated; and

**WHEREAS**, the operation of any such vehicle shall be subject to the following conditions or restrictions:

- a. Operators shall be 16 or older and have a valid driver's license.
- b. The riding times are during daylight hours, which include the thirty (30) minutes before dawn and the thirty (30) minutes after dusk.
- c. Riders must stay on designed and posted roads.
- d. Riders must carry liability insurance and be able to provide proof if requested.
- e. All riders must wear a protective helmet of a type approved by Tennessee Department of Transportation.
- f. Riders must lawfully obey all rules of the road applicable to other motor vehicles.
- g. Any such vehicle operated within Campbell County, TN on approved roads shall be operated in a safe manner.
- h. Regular safety checkpoints will be conducted to ensure that rides are following procedures.
- i. Subject to any and all applicable laws as required and established by the State of Tennessee.
- j. Any violation to the State of Tennessee laws and rules listed here may result in loss of privileges to operate vehicle on the specified roads named in this Resolution.

**WHEREAS**, violators of the provisions of this Resolution, which are not a violation of TCA 55-8-185, shall be punished by a civil penalty of no more than \$50.00 and/or loss of permit; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by Campbell County Board of Commissioners meeting in Regular Session the 21<sup>st</sup> day of February, 2017; that:

**Section 1.** All-terrain vehicles are ATV, UTV, dirt bikes and similar type vehicles determined to be suitable and appropriate for safe operation on the streets of Campbell County, TN

**Section 2.** Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, any all-terrain vehicles may be operated on the following portions of highways/roads within the jurisdiction of Campbell County, Tennessee.

See attached list of county roads and approved sections of state highways.

**Section 3.** Whereas, the operation of any such vehicle shall be subject to the following conditions or restrictions:

- a. Operators shall be 16 or older and have a valid driver's license.
- b. The riding times are during daylight hours, which include the thirty (30) minutes before dawn and the thirty (30) minutes after dusk.
- c. Riders must stay on designed and posted roads.
- d. Riders must carry liability insurance and be able to provide proof if requested.
- e. All riders must wear a protective helmet of a type approved by Tennessee Department of Transportation
- f. Riders must lawfully obey all rules of the road applicable to other motor vehicles.
- g. Any such vehicle operated within Campbell County, TN on approved roads shall be operated in a safe manner.
- h. Regular safety checkpoints will be conducted to ensure that rides are following procedures.
- i. Subject to any and all applicable laws as required and established by the State of Tennessee.
- j. Any violation to the State of Tennessee laws and rules listed here may result in loss of privileges to operate vehicle on the specified roads named in this Resolution.

**Section 4.** Violators of the provisions of this Resolution, which are not a violation of TCA 55-8-185, shall be punished by a civil penalty of no more than \$50.00 and/or loss of permit

**Section 5.** This Resolution shall become effective 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2017.
